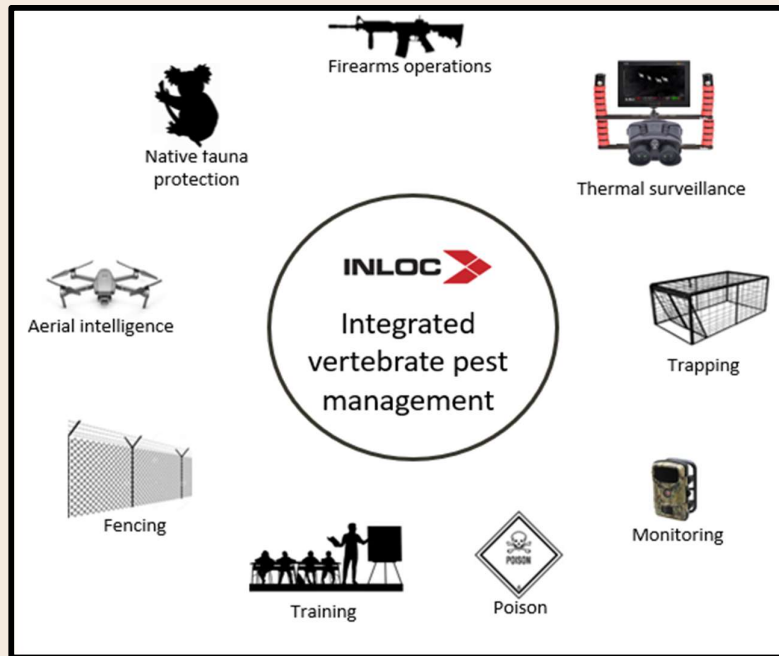

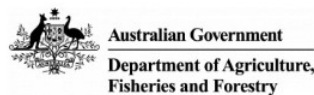
Pricing methodology
